• Allocated 08:33

• Mobile 08:35

• On scene 08:39

• Left Scene 09:02

• At hospital 09:09

• 22 minutes spent on scene treating patient and moving him to ambulance.

PATIENT POSITION & APPEARANCE

- Male lying supine in outside doorway, naked from waist up.
- Alert but very pale
- Member of the public applying pressure to wound using patient's t-shirt
- Air temperature approximately 7-8 °C.
- Back up from 2 crew requested
- Hospital contacted via radio to request a trauma team be ready to receive patient

PATIENT ASSESSMENT

• Primary survey: checked the position and size of wounds – approx. 3cm to upper left chest and minor laceration to right forearm, some bleeding (<500ml)

• Observations BP 102/66

HR 116

Sp02 97%

RR 24

Temp. 34.4 °C.

GCS 15

 Secondary survey, checked patient head to toe for an other injuries, no further stab wounds but patient had open sores in both groins due to IVDU

TREATMENT & REMOVAL TO AMBULANCE

- No IV access possible due to IVDU and reduced BP
- Tranexamic acid lg given IM
- Wound dressed using Prometheus trauma/pressure dressing
- Patient wrapped in blankets and removed using scoop stretcher up to ambulance
- Hospital updated regarding patient's condition and obs
- Patient transported to Gilbert Bain Hospital A/E
